- 1. If you could summarize the sermon in 30sec.-1min for group members who didn't hear it, what would you say?
- 2. What was one thing that really "stuck with you" from the sermon?
- 3. What new ("I never thought of that before") insight did you gain from the sermon?
- 4. How does the context of the passage help in interpreting the specific text?
- 5. How does the text or the sermon increase your appreciation for the gospel?
- 6. What characteristics of God are highlighted in the text or sermon?
- 7. Can you summarize in a sentence one biblical principle from the text or sermon?
- 8. Was there anything from the text or sermon that challenged you and was hard to hear?
- 9. Were there any specific words or phrases in the text that you struggled with?
- 10. What unresolved questions does the topic, text, or sermon raise for you?

Application

- 1. How are you personally challenged to grow or change because of the text or sermon?
- 2. In what ways have you or can you put this particular word to work this week?
- 3. What could be the personal or corporate consequences of not heeding the text or sermon?
- 4. If this text or sermon was diligently applied, what difference would it make to your choices, schedule, priorities, time, etc.?
- 5. If this text or sermon had its intended effect, what difference would it make in your life, home, church, etc.?
